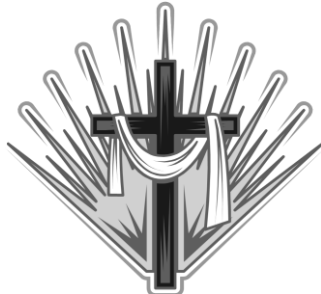

**We now have a new relic cabinet** in the Shrine Chapel at Launceston. The previous one was worm-eaten and insecure. The new cabinet will be blessed at Mass next week. Catholics, like all Christians, believe in the Communion of Saints. In other words we believe that we can help each other by our prayers (“say one for me”), and those who have gone before us in faith can help us too. We venerate the physical remains of Saints not out of superstition but because they are a tangible reminder of what the Saints achieved in their life on earth.

**Belief in the Communion of Saints** is stated in the Apostles’ Creed with which we renew our Promises of Baptism every Easter. The new translation of the Missal encourages us to use this creed during the season of Easter, rather than the usual Nicene Creed. We shall do this as Easter is very closely associated with Baptism. The words are to be found on the usual Mass cards.

**The relic cabinet** was made by Robert Jones, a relative of Philip Stephenson, who has kindly donated it. It is made of sapele and English sycamore with mahogany veneer. It was delivered to our church on 10<sup>th</sup> March. There are six relics in the shrine. There are two bone fragments of St Cuthbert Mayne, a bone fragment of St John Southworth, martyred at Tyburn in 1654, a bone fragment of St Thérèse of Lisieux, who died in 1897 and was canonised in 1925. This relic of St Thérèse was given to me by the nuns of Sclerder Abbey as a leaving present. There is a relic of Pope St Pius X, canonised in 1954. The other relic has not yet been identified.
