This was first published in French in 1992 and in English in 1994. During this Year of Faith I should like to select items from it. Not an easy task, as the CCC has 2,865 paragraphs.

5. Catechesis is an education in the faith of children, young people and adults ...

11. This catechism aims at presenting an organic synthesis of the essential and fundamental contents of Catholic doctrine, as regards both faith and morals, in the light of the Second Vatican Council and the whole of the Church's Tradition. Its principal sources are the Sacred Scriptures, the Fathers of the Church, the liturgy, and the Church's Magisterium (teaching authority).

13. The plan of this catechism is inspired by the great tradition of catechisms which build catechesis on four pillars: what Catholics believe, the seven sacraments, how Catholics live, how Catholics pray.
