The Year of Faith: from the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted).

Paragraph 514: Many things about Jesus of interest to human curiosity do not figure in the Gospels. Almost nothing is said about his hidden life at Nazareth, and even a great part of his public life is not recounted. What was written in the Gospels was set down there “so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that believing you may have life in his name.” (John 20:31)

The feedback from our visitors was that both lunch and Service were excellent, and raised £191.25 to be shared between CAFOD and Christian Aid – a magnificent amount!

- ❖ The Finance Committee meets on Wednesday 6th February at 11am at Bude to approve spending plans for 2013. If you have any matters you would like to raise, please ask Dave Thomas (Treasurer) or me.
- ❖ We have banked £214.22 from the sale of Diocesan Year Books and Parish Histories. Keep up the good work, because we need the money.
- ❖ While on the subject of money, our Parish has been awarded a grant of £1,500 from the Guild of Our Lady of Ransom, an organisation which supports parishes with a limited income such as ours. I have written to thank Bishop Christopher and the Guild.
