The Year of Faith: from the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted).

Paragraph 1486: The forgiveness of sins committed after Baptism is conferred by a particular sacrament called the sacrament of conversion, confession, Penance or Reconciliation.

Paragraph 1423: It is called the *sacrament of conversion* because it makes sacramentally present Jesus' call to conversion, the first step in returning to the Father from whom one has strayed by sin.

It is called the *sacrament of Penance*, since it consecrates the Christian sinner's steps of conversion, penance and satisfaction.

Paragraph 1424: It is called the *sacrament of confession*, since the disclosure or confession of sins to a priest is an essential element of this sacrament. In a profound sense it is also a 'confession' – acknowledgement and praise – of the holiness of God and of his mercy towards sinful man.

It is called the *sacrament of forgiveness*, since by the priest's sacramental absolution God grants the penitent 'pardon and peace'.

It is called the *sacrament of Reconciliation*, because it imparts to the sinner the love of God who reconciles.

- ❖ Bude: Remember the Lenten Lunch that we are co-hosting with St. Martin's URC Church, Killerton Road, in their hall this coming Wednesday, March 20<sup>th</sup>, from 12 noon – 2pm. It is in aid of Emmaus, a housing charity running hostels and workshops for the homeless, enabling them to learn a skill with a view to being able to live independently and self-sufficiently again if possible; if not, they have a home for as long as necessary. We are supporting a scheme

near Truro which is due to open this summer. A member of the team involved in getting the project up and running will be at the lunch to give first hand information of needs and progress. Such a scheme is much needed here in Cornwall, so do support it if you can.

- ❖ Bude: There will be a performance of Handel's Oratorio "Judas Maccabaeus" on Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> March at St. Michael's Church (near the canal) at 7.30pm. A musical feast.

- ❖ Holy Week begins next week with Palm Sunday. There will be a Procession of Palms and a reading of the Passion of Our Lord according to St. Luke. The procession at Launceston will begin in the Charles Langdon Room.
- ❖ Stations of the Cross at 3.00pm on Friday at St. Peter and St. Paul Church, Holsworthy.
- ❖ Bishop Christopher has written a Pastoral Letter which will be read and distributed today.
- ❖ The venerable tradition of veiling the crosses and images in our churches will be observed from today, as we approach Holy Week and the Suffering and Death of Our Lord.
