

- † Thank you for your continued generosity in donating food for the work of the SVP Society. We have received so much recently that in agreement with the SVP some food will be offered to the Food Bank in Launceston. Arrangements in Bude will be unchanged.
- † I am most grateful for your generous Easter Offering in these straitened times. Thank you so much. I should also like to thank all who gave me cards and chocolates (quickly consumed!) and to thank all of you who helped with the Holy Week and Easter ceremonies, especially musicians, flower arrangers, servers, readers and perhaps most importantly of all, for your presence.
- † During the Easter Monday holiday, I measured the length and breadth of this Parish, with the help of my chariot. From the Devon border in the north to Bolventor in the south the distance is approximately 36 miles using the main roads, and I took one hour to complete the journey. From north of Boscastle in the west to Bratton Clovelly in the east the distance is

approximately 30 miles, again using the main roads where possible. The journey time was one hour. Thank goodness Launceston is roughly in the middle. I drive nearly 1,000 miles a month while on parish duties. And I don't even like driving!

- † The Filipino community will be celebrating a Thanksgiving Mass next Tuesday 9th April at Launceston, at the usual time.
- † Hymn Books: Ours have become rather shabby and out of date. I have done a consultation exercise with our musicians and liturgists and asked advice from priests and musicians. Almost unanimously they advised getting the revised edition of the Celebration Hymnal for Everyone. This new edition, approved by the Bishops' Conference, has a smart plastic cover and also contains the Mass settings we often use. There is also an Order of Mass and so we will no longer have to give out Mass cards. We shall use the new hymn books today for the first time.
- † In spite of getting a large discount and an extra discount for early payment, equipping two churches has not been cheap. To help finance this major purchase I am inviting you to buy a label, to be inserted in a hymn book in memory of a loved one. If you are interested, please take a form, fill it in and return with £5.
- † The second Sunday of Easter is Divine Mercy Sunday, an excellent chance to fulfil your Easter duty if you have not already done so. Divine Mercy will be celebrated at Lanherne Convent (St. Mawgan, near Newquay) and Plymouth Cathedral from 2.30 pm.
- † The annual Cornish Pilgrimage to Walsingham takes place from 27th October to 2nd November. For details please see the notice.
- † Next meeting for First Holy Communion candidates and their parents: after the Youth Mass on 14th April, in the church.


