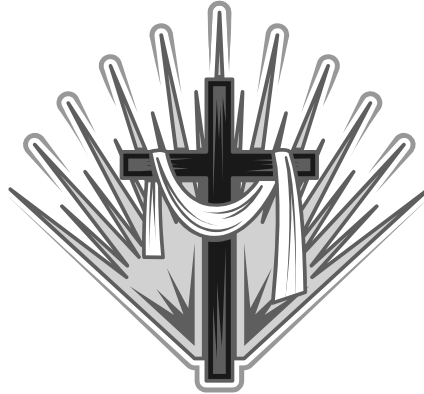

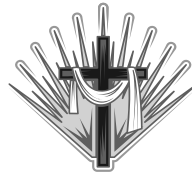

The Year of Faith: from the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted).

Paragraph 1090: 'In the earthly liturgy we share in a foretaste of that heavenly liturgy which is celebrated in the Holy City of Jerusalem towards which we journey as pilgrims, where Christ is sitting at the right hand of God, Minister of the sanctuary and of the true tabernacle.'

Paragraph 1137: The book of *Revelation* of St. John, read in the Church's liturgy, first reveals to us, 'A throne stood in heaven, with one seated on the throne': 'the Lord God'. It then shows the Lamb, 'standing as though it had been slain': Christ crucified and risen, the one high priest of the true sanctuary, the same one 'who offers and is offered, who gives and is given'.
