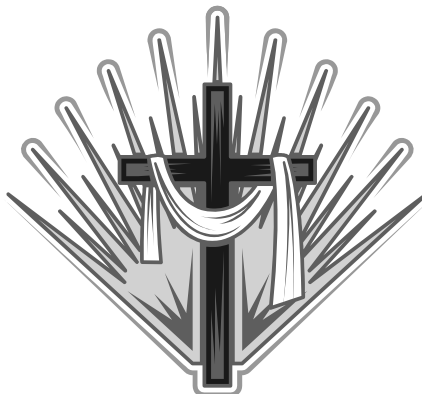

The Year of Faith: from the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted).

Paragraph 1042: The Church...will receive her perfection only in the glory of heaven, when will come the time of the renewal of all things. At that time, together with the human race, the universe itself, which is so closely related to man and which attains its destiny through him, will be perfectly re-established in Christ.

Paragraph 1043: Sacred Scripture calls this mysterious renewal, which will transform humanity and the world, 'new heavens and a new earth'. It will be the definitive realisation of God's plan to bring all under a single head 'all things in [Christ], things in heaven and things on earth'.

Paragraph 1044: In this new universe, the heavenly Jerusalem, God will have his dwelling among men. 'He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning nor crying nor pain any more, for the former things have passed away.'
