The Year of Faith: from the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted).

- Paragraph 2773: In response to his disciples' request 'Lord, teach us to pray' (Lk11:1), Jesus entrusts them with the fundamental Christian prayer, the Our Father.
- Paragraph 2774: 'The Lord's Prayer is truly the summery of the whole gospel', the 'most perfect of prayers'. It is at the centre of the Scriptures.
- Paragraph 2775: It is called 'the Lord's Prayer' because it comes to us from the Lord Jesus, the master and model of our prayer.
- Paragraph 2762: Run through all the words of the holy prayers [in Scripture], and I do not think that you will find anything in them that is not contained and included in the Lord's Prayer.
- Paragraph 2763: The Lord's Prayer is the most perfect of prayers...In it we ask, not only for all the things we can rightly desire, but also in the sequence that they should be desired. This prayer teaches us not only to ask for things, but also in what order we should desire them.

- ❖ Another Day with St. Benedict to be held at Buckfast Abbey on Saturday 3rd August beginning at 10 am. See poster for details.
- ❖ Also at Buckfast Abbey, 26th-31st August, "Shadowlands" to mark the 50th anniversary of the death of the well-known Christian writer C.S. Lewis. See poster for details.
- ❖ At the Youth Mass on 8th September prayer books and certificates will be given to those children who recently made their First Holy Communion.
- ❖ No Adoration on Tuesday 23rd and 30th July, but the church can be opened by prior arrangement with Pat Bailey.

- ❖ The first Street Pastors for Launceston will be commissioned on Saturday 27th July at 7.30 pm at the Central Methodist Hall, Launceston. You are welcome to attend, and offer your prayerful support.
- ❖ The URC Church at Bude now has a new Minister, Rev. Barbara Bennett. She will be inducted at a Service on Saturday 31st August at 2.30pm.
- ❖ Plans for the interior of St. Cuthbert Mayne church: following the earlier Parish Consultation regarding our external building plans, we are now ready to present plans for the church interior. We have three alternative proposals and I am keen that there should be a full and frank discussion of these. Without your wholehearted approval, the Bishop will quite rightly not let the project go ahead.
- ❖ The Ordinariate of Our Lady of Walsingham, which is well represented in this Diocese, has asked whether they can come to Launceston on pilgrimage on Saturday 14th September. I believe this is a great honour for our parish, and I hope to be able to count on your support. More details will be publicised when available.
- ❖ Fr. David Gassor is gradually settling into his new home at Topsham. The parishioners at Bude started a collection for him and have raised £201.10. I should like to keep the collection going for a little while longer at Launceston. We were a bit slow starting (my fault).
- ❖ First Holy Communion for children of 7-8 years, and Confirmation for young people of 14 plus. I hope to begin programmes this September leading to celebratory Masses during the season of Easter. Parents who are interested should ask me for details over the next few weeks.
- ❖ Starting from this Sunday, there will be a small exhibition of photos from our Parish Archives in the Charles Langdon Room. I plan to change the display about once a month just to give you some idea of what we have in our collection of photos.
