The Year of Faith: from the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted).

Paragraph 144: To obey (from the Latin *ob-audire*, to 'hear or listen to') in faith is to submit freely to the word that has been heard, because its truth is guaranteed by God, who is Truth itself. Abraham is the model of such obedience offered us by Sacred Scripture. The Virgin Mary is its most perfect embodiment.

Paragraph 179: Faith is a supernatural gift from God. In order to believe, man needs the interior helps of the Holy Spirit.

Paragraph 180: 'Believing' is a human act, conscious and free, corresponding to the dignity of the human person.

Paragraph 157: Faith is *certain*. It is more certain than all human knowledge because it is founded on the very word of God who cannot lie.

- ❖ The collection for Fr. David Gassor at Launceston totalled £299.49. Thank you for your generosity.

- ❖ Plans to improve the foyer at Bude were passed by the local planning authority. The church at Bude is not a listed building so we can now go ahead within a few months.
- ❖ Plans of the renovations at Launceston are on display in the Charles Langdon Room and also at Bude. I am meeting the Diocesan Property Manager later this week to keep him informed.
- ❖ Thursday 15th August is the Solemnity of the Assumption (i.e. taking up) of Our Lady. It is a Holy Day of Obligation when all should try to attend Mass.
- ❖ Please pray for the parishioners at St. Mary Magdalene Church (Launceston). Their church building has had to close indefinitely because of structural damage. See noticeboard for more details.

- ❖ Current photo display in the Charles Langdon Room: 1920s and 1930s.
- ❖ I have found some material relating to life in Bude parish in the 1950s and 1960s. Please ask if you would like to look.
- ❖ For the Polish Community: there will be a Mass in Polish at Launceston on Sunday 13th October pm. More details to be available soon.
- ❖ Parish Census: the last one was completed in Summer 2010. If you are a newcomer or your details have changed, please complete a yellow form, to be found at the back of the church.
- ❖ I need a Gift Aid rep at the Launceston end of the parish. No awful paperwork involved. Any offers?
- ❖ At the Youth Mass on 8th September prayer books and certificates will be given to those children who recently made their First Holy Communion.
- ❖ The URC Church at Bude now has a new Minister, Rev. Barbara Bennett. She will be inducted at a Service on Saturday 31st August at 2.30pm.
- ❖ First Holy Communion for children of 7-8 years, and Confirmation for young people of 14 plus. I hope to begin programmes this September leading to celebratory Masses during the season of Easter. Parents who are interested should ask me for details over the next few weeks.
