The Year of Faith: from the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted).

Paragraph 962: 'We believe in the communion of all the faithful of Christ, those who are pilgrims on earth, the dead who are being purified, and the blessed in heaven, all together forming one Church; and we believe that in this communion, the merciful love of God and his saints is always attentive to our prayers' (Paul VI, CPG 30).

Paragraph 956: *The intercession of the saints.* 'Being more closely united to Christ, those who dwell in heaven fix the whole church more firmly in holiness...they do not cease to intercede with the father for us, as they proffer the merits which they acquired on earth through the one mediator between God and men, Christ Jesus...So by their fraternal concern is our weakness greatly helped.
