The Year of Faith: from the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted).

- Paragraph 1947: The equal dignity of human persons requires the effort to reduce excessive social and economic inequalities. It gives urgency to the elimination of sinful inequalities.
- Paragraph 1948: Solidarity is an eminently Christian virtue. It practises the sharing of spiritual goods even more than material ones.
- Paragraph 2590: 'Prayer is the raising of one's mind and heart to God or the requesting of good things from God' (*St. John Damascene*)
- Paragraph 2680: Prayer is primarily addressed to the Father; it can also be directed toward Jesus, particularly by the invocation of this holy name: 'Lord Jesus Christ, Son of God, have mercy on us sinners.'
- Paragraph 2757: 'Pray constantly' (*1 Th 5:17*). It is always possible to pray. It is even a vital necessity. Prayer and Christian life are inseparable.



- ❖ There is a reduced schedule of Masses after 13th October. Please look carefully at the newsletter.
- ❖ Meetings: Confirmation Group on Wednesday 23rd October at 6pm. First Holy Communion Groups on Wednesday 23rd October at 4pm (Bude) and Tuesday 5th November at 6.15pm (Launceston). I will confirm these dates by email.
- ❖ There will be a retiring collection on Sunday 20th October for the World Missions.
- ❖ Mass Count, Week 1: we got off to a good start with 77 at Bude and 126 at Launceston. The target is 200 per week, so we have achieved this. Can we do as well for the rest of the month?
- ❖ Bude: £53 was raised for CAFOD from the Harvest produce displayed at Mass last Saturday. Many thanks to all who contributed, Nikki and Peter Ware.
- ❖ October is traditionally the month of the Rosary. If you would like me to visit you at home and pray the Rosary with you, please ask.
- ❖ Bude: The Sanctuary will be re-arranged as from 7th October. I should like to have the wall behind the altar painted dark red and the opposite wall light blue, with the other walls in magnolia. Any comments will be gratefully received.
- ❖ The Books of Remembrance are to be up-dated for November. I should be grateful if you would let me have any names of deceased relatives and friends as soon as possible.
- ❖ 1st December will be the 100th anniversary of the death of Canon Langdon, our first parish priest. Any ideas on how we might celebrate? A bibulous wake, perhaps?
- ❖ Red Boxes: please return these as soon as possible to Debbie Vickerstaff (Bude) or Philip Stephenson and Joseph Hickey (Launceston).
- ❖ Launceston: I will use the window ledges in the porch for newspapers, handouts, etc. That should make them a bit more visible.

- ❖ Launceston: I should like to try a more efficient way of distributing Holy Communion. I will stand near the organ and invite people on the organ side to come up first. They then go to the Ministers with chalices, who will be standing next to each other at the foot of the sanctuary step. This will avoid clambering up and down steps and I hope improve the circulation. If it doesn't work, we'll think again!
- ❖ **TODAY AND THROUGHOUT OCTOBER: ANNUAL MASS COUNT.** It is very important that we try to keep up our numbers at both churches. If our numbers drop significantly, we may face more amalgamations. Heaven forbid!
