From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted).

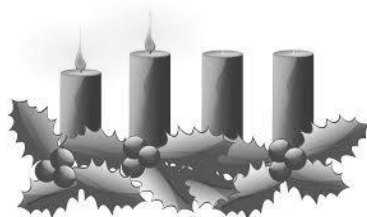
