From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted).

Paragraph 2763: All the Scriptures – the Law, the Prophets and the Psalms – are fulfilled in Christ. The Gospel is this ‘Good News’. Its first proclamation is summarised by St. Matthew in the Sermon on the Mount.

Paragraph 782: The People of God is marked by characteristics that clearly distinguish it from all other religious, ethnic, political or cultural groups found in history. Its mission is to be salt of the earth and light of the world. This people is ‘a most sure seed of unity, hope and salvation for the whole human race’.

Paragraph 764: ‘This kingdom shines out before men in the word, in the works and in the presence of Christ.’ To welcome Jesus’ word is to welcome ‘the Kingdom itself’. The seed and beginning of the Kingdom are the ‘little flock’ of those whom Jesus came to gather around him, the flock whose shepherd he is. They form Jesus’ true family. To those whom he thus gathered around him, he taught a new ‘way of acting’ and a prayer of their own.
