- ❖ Last Monday's Service to mark the Dissolution of Launceston Priory on 24th February 1539 was well attended despite the rain. Thank you to those from this parish who supported this ecumenical venture.
- ❖ The Minutes from last Sunday's PPC meeting are on the notice boards and are also available online. Approval for our building plans was unanimous.
- ❖ Congratulations to Amalia and Gerardo Toledo who are training to be Ministers of Holy Communion. And also to Lennox Kirkby and Florrie Spreadbury who have joined the team of altar servers.
- ❖ Parking in Mayne Close still causes a few problems because of congestion in the narrow road. Some of the able-bodied might consider parking in Hollies Road or St. Cuthbert Close, both nearby.
- ❖ With the consent of the PPC I propose to place some of our parish records in the Diocesan Archives where they will be professionally cared for. If you have strong views against doing this, please tell me.

- ❖ Confirmation Class 2014: Bishop Mark is unable to be with us on Sunday 27th April as planned. He has asked us to accept Sunday 15th June instead. I hope this alteration will not create a problem for anyone. Next meeting: Wednesday 12th March, same time, same place.
- ❖ First Holy Communion 2014: The Mass planned for Pentecost Sunday, 8th June, remains unchanged. Next meeting: Tuesday 11th March, same time, same place.
- ❖ Building works:
 - Launceston: work on the new driveway and new buildings continues despite bad weather and bureaucratic delays.
 - Bude: work on the interior of the extension continues.
- ❖ Lenten Station Mass on Thursday 13th March at 7pm at Truro Catholic Church. The main concelebrant is Bishop Mark. Everyone is welcome. I have to be at a Deanery Day beforehand and despite what I said last Sunday, I am unable to offer lifts. Sorry!
- ❖ Women's World Day of Prayer (Launceston) to be held in St. Cuthbert Mayne church on Friday 7th March at 2.30pm. All welcome, including men. Refreshments available afterwards.
- ❖ Women's World Day of Prayer (Holsworthy) will be held at St. Peter and St. Paul Parish Church at 11am on Friday 7th March, followed by a Bring & Share lunch. This year, the service is being hosted by the Catholics.
- ❖ Women's World Day of Prayer (Bude) will be held at St. Olaf's Church, Poughill at 10.30am on Friday 7th March, followed by refreshments, which will include 'tasters' of Egyptian food. Men are also very welcome.
