From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted).

Paragraph 1275: Christian initiation is accomplished by three sacraments together: Baptism which is the beginning of new life; Confirmation which is its strengthening; and the Eucharist which nourishes the disciple with Christ's Body and Blood for his transformation in Christ.

Paragraph 1213: Holy Baptism is the basis of the whole Christian life, the gateway to life in the Spirit (*vitae spiritualis ianua*), and the door which gives access to the other sacraments.

Paragraph 1280: Baptism prints on the soul an indelible spiritual sign, the character, which consecrates the baptised person for Christian worship. Because of the character Baptism cannot be repeated.

Paragraph 1282: Since the earliest times, Baptism has been administered to children, for it is a grace and a gift of God that does not presuppose any human merit.
