From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted).

Paragraph 569: Jesus went up to Jerusalem voluntarily, knowing well that there he would die a violent death because of the opposition of sinners.

Paragraph 621: Jesus freely offered himself for our salvation. Beforehand, during the Last Supper, he both symbolised this offering and made it really present: 'This is my body which is given for you'.

Paragraph 623: By his loving obedience to the Father, 'unto death, even death on a cross' (*Phil 2:8*), Jesus fulfils the atoning mission of the suffering Servant, who will 'make many righteous; and he shall bear their iniquities' (*Is 53:11*)
