From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted).

Paragraph 638: The Resurrection of Jesus is the crowning truth of our faith in Christ, a faith believed and lived as the central truth by the first Christian community; handed on as fundamental by Tradition; established by the documents of the New Testament; and preached as an essential part of the Paschal mystery along with the cross.

Paragraph 639: The mystery of Christ's resurrection is a real event, with manifestations that were historically verified, as the New Testament bears witness.
