From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted).

Paragraph 857: The Church is apostolic because she is founded on the apostles, in three ways:
- she was and remains built on 'the foundation of the apostles', the witnesses chosen and sent on mission by Christ himself;
- with the help of the Spirit dwelling in her, the Church keeps and hands on the teaching, the 'good deposit', the salutary words she has heard from the apostles;
- she continues to be taught, sanctified and guided by the apostles until Christ's return, through their successors in pastoral office: the college of bishops, 'assisted by priests in union with the successor of Peter, the Church's supreme pastor'.

Paragraph 870: The sole Church of Christ which in the Creed we profess to be one, holy, catholic and apostolic,...subsists in the Catholic Church, which is governed by the successor of Peter and by the bishops in communion with him. Nevertheless, many elements of sanctification and of truth are found outside its visible confines.
