From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted).

Paragraph 525: Jesus was born in a humble stable, into a poor family. Simple shepherds were the first witness to this event. In this poverty heaven's glory was made manifest.

Jesus conquers the Daughter of Zion, a figure of his Church, neither by ruse nor by violence, but by the humility that bears witness to the truth.
