From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted).

Paragraph 1054: Those who die in God's grace and friendship imperfectly purified, although they are assured of their eternal salvation, undergo a purification after death, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of God.

Paragraph 1055: By virtue of the 'communion of saints', the Church commends the dead to God's mercy and offers her prayers, especially the holy sacrifice of the Eucharist, on their behalf.

Paragraph 1057: Hell's principal punishment consists of eternal separation from God in whom alone man can have the life and happiness for which he was created and for which he longs.

Paragraph 1058: The Church prays that no one should be lost: 'Lord, let me never be parted from you.' If it is true that no one can save himself, it is also true that God 'desires all men to be saved' (*1 Tim 2:4*), and that for him 'all things are possible' (*Mt 19:26*).
