From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted).

Paragraph 936: The Lord made St. Peter the visible foundation of his Church. He entrusted the keys of the Church to him. The bishop of the Church of Rome, successor to St. Peter, is 'head of the college of bishops, the Vicar of Christ and Pastor of the universal Church on earth'.

Paragraph 937: The Pope enjoys, by divine institution, 'supreme, full, immediate and universal power in the care of souls'.

Paragraph 938: The bishops, established by the Holy Spirit, succeed the apostles. They are 'the visible source and foundation of unity in their own particular Churches'.

Paragraph 941: Lay people share in Christ's priesthood: ever more united with him, they exhibit the grace of Baptism and Confirmation in all dimensions of their personal, family, social and ecclesial lives, and so fulfil the call to holiness addressed to all the baptised.

Paragraph 942: By virtue of their prophetic mission, lay people 'are called...to be witnesses to Christ in all circumstances and at the very heart of the community of mankind'.
