From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted).

Paragraph 1833: Virtue is a habitual and firm disposition to do good.

Paragraph 1840: The theological virtues dispose Christians to live in a relationship with the Holy Trinity. They have God for their origin, their motive and their object – God known by faith, God hoped in and loved for his own sake.

Paragraph 1823: Jesus makes charity the new commandment. By loving his own ‘to the end’, he makes manifest the Father’s love which he receives. By loving one another, the disciples imitate the love of Jesus which they themselves receive. Whence Jesus says: ‘As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you; abide in my love.’ And again: ‘This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you.’
