From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted).

Paragraph 619: 'Christ died for our sins in accordance with the scriptures' (*1 Cor 15:3*)

Paragraph 620: Our salvation flows from God's initiative of love for us, because 'he loved us and sent his Son to be the expiation for our sins' (*1 Jn 4:10*). 'God was in Christ reconciling the world to himself' (*2 Cor 5:19*)

Paragraph 621: Jesus freely offered himself for our salvation. Beforehand, during the Last Supper, he both symbolised this offering and made it really present: 'This is my body which is given for you' (*Lk 22:19*)

Paragraph 623: By his loving obedience to the Father, 'unto death, even death on a cross' (*Phil 2:8*), Jesus fulfils the atoning mission of the suffering Servant, who will 'make many righteous; and he shall bear their iniquities' (*Is 53:11*)
