From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 1796: Conscience is a judgement of reason by which the human person recognises the moral quality of a concrete act.

Paragraph 1783: Conscience must be informed and moral judgement enlightened. A well-formed conscience is upright and truthful. It formulates its judgements according to reason, in conformity with the true good willed by the wisdom of the Creator.

Paragraph 2255: It is the duty of citizens to work with civil authority for building up society in a spirit of truth, justice, solidarity and freedom.

Paragraph 2256: Citizens are obliged in conscience not to follow the directives of civil authorities when they are contrary to the demands of the moral order. 'We must obey God rather than men' (Acts 5:29)
