From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 828: By canonising some of the faithful, i.e. by solemnly proclaiming that they practised heroic virtue and lived in fidelity to God's grace, the Church recognises the power of the Spirit of holiness within her and sustains the hope of believers by proposing the saints to them as models and intercessors.

Paragraph 954: The three states of the Church: 'When the Lord comes in glory and all his angels with him, death will be no more and all things will be subject to him. But at the present time some of his disciples are pilgrims on earth. Others have died and are being purified, while still others are in glory, contemplating "in full light, God himself, triune and one, exactly as he is".'

Paragraph 956: 'Do not weep, for I shall be more useful to you after my death and I shall help you then more effectively than during my life'. (St. Dominic, dying, to his brothers)

'I want to spend my heaven in doing good on earth.' (St. Thérèse of Lisieux)
