From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 484: The Annunciation to Mary inaugurates 'the fullness of time', the time of the fulfilment of God's promises and preparations. Mary was invited to conceive him in whom the 'whole fullness of deity' would dwell 'bodily'. The divine response to her question, 'How can this be, since I know not man?', was given by the power of the Spirit: 'The Holy Spirit will come upon you.'

Paragraph 490: To become the mother of the Saviour, Mary 'was enriched by God with gifts appropriate to such a role.' The angel Gabriel at the moment of the annunciation salutes her as 'full of grace'.

Paragraph 491: Through the centuries the Church has become ever more aware that Mary, 'full of grace' through God, was redeemed from the moment of her conception. That is what the dogma of the Immaculate Conception confesses, as Pope Pius IX proclaimed in 1854.
