From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 364: The human body shares in the dignity of 'the image of God': it is a human body precisely because it is animated by a spiritual soul, and it is the whole human person that is intended to become, in the body of Christ, a temple of the Spirit.

Paragraph 1766: 'To love is to will the good of another.' All other affections have their source in this first movement of the human heart towards the good. Only the good can be loved. Passions 'are evil if love is evil and good if it is good.'

Paragraph 2351: Lust is disordered desire for or inordinate enjoyment of sexual pleasure. Sexual pleasure is morally disordered when sought for itself, isolated from its procreative and unitive purposes.
