From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 567: The kingdom of heaven was inaugurated on earth by Christ. 'This kingdom shone out before men in the word, in the works and in the presence of Christ'. The Church is the seed and beginning of this kingdom. Its keys are entrusted to Peter.

Paragraph 547: Jesus accompanies his words with many 'mighty works and wonders and signs', which manifest that the kingdom is present in him and attest that he was the promised Messiah.

Paragraph 1947: The equal dignity of human persons requires the effort to reduce excessive social and economic inequalities. It gives urgency to the elimination of sinful inequalities.

Paragraph 1948: Solidarity is an eminently Christian virtue. It practises the sharing of spiritual goods even more than material ones.
