From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 72: God chose Abraham and made a covenant with him and his descendants. By the covenant God formed his people and revealed his law to them through Moses. Through the prophets, he prepared them to accept the salvation destined for all humanity.

❖ **Holy Week and Easter Liturgies and Devotions.** As Lent draws to a close the statues and crosses are veiled as a sign of mourning for the death of Our Lord.

- ❖ Wednesday 1st April at noon: Chrism Mass in Plymouth Cathedral. All welcome.
- ❖ Thursday 2nd April at 7pm: The Triduum begins with Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper and Watching at the Altar of Repose until 9.30pm approx.
- ❖ Friday 3rd April: Day of Fasting and Abstinence: at 3pm: Solemn Celebration of the Lord's Passion.
- ❖ Additional devotions on Good Friday: Stations of the Cross at Bude at 10.30am and at Callington at 5pm. Walk of Witness at Bude at noon.
- ❖ Saturday 4th April: noon: Blessing of Easter Food for the Polish Community in the Church Hall at Launceston: at 8.30pm: Easter Vigil.
- ❖ The Triduum Liturgies will be at Launceston.
- ❖ Easter Sunday 5th April: Mass at Callington at 8.00am, Bude and Launceston at 10.00am. No evening Mass at Callington.

- ❖ From today the new organ at Launceston will be played in public for the first time. After Easter the organ builder will complete some more refinements.
- ❖ We now have a team of twelve Altar Servers at Launceston. I should like to have a group photo taken after Mass on Easter Sunday and would be grateful if parents and friends could bring cameras. Very few parishes in the Diocese have such a large number.
- ❖ Palm Sunday at Launceston: Please meet in the Charles Langdon Room unless wet.
- ❖ Thank you, all who have volunteered your help at Launceston. I'll be able to put you to work after Easter.

- ❖ There will be a retiring collection for Easter flowers next Sunday.
- ❖ Please put clocks forward one hour next Saturday evening.
- ❖ I should like to thank Hilary and David Rhodes for donating a garden bench for our churchyard, and varnishing it. Peter the gardener has promised to attach it securely.
- ❖ Very advance notices:
 - 3rd May 2015: Flores de Mayo and Santacruzian celebration in honour of Our Lady, organised by the Filipino community. Begins in Exeter city centre at 3.30pm. You are all welcome to take part.
 - July 2016: World Youth Day in Krakow, Poland. For young adults who will be 16+ by then. More information: type WYD 2016 Plymouth and Clifton into google. I am keen to send at least two from our parish and would encourage parish sponsorship for them. See poster.

 1. Over-networking: check your social media sites no more than once a day.
 2. Unkind thoughts and words: do not say or even think anything that condemns others.
 3. Unnecessary noise: whenever possible, turn off the TV and radio. Listen for God's still, small voice.
- ❖ **Lent Liturgies 2015:**

At Mass: No Alleluia or Gloria; sung plainsong Kyrie eleison (Greek: Lord have mercy), Sanctus and Agnus Dei; Apostles Creed said in English, sung Memorial Acclamation No. 3 Save us, Saviour of the World... You will find the music in the Celebration Hymn Book: Kyrie 467, Sanctus 470, Agnus Dei 473.
- ❖ The next Coffee Morning in the Charles Langdon Room will be on Tuesday 7th April from 10.30 am. You are all welcome to join us.
