From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

- Paragraph 619: 'Christ died for our sins in accordance with the scriptures' (1 Cor 15:3)
- Paragraph 621: Jesus freely offered himself for our salvation. Beforehand, during the Last Supper, he both symbolised this offering and made it really present: 'This is my body which is given for you' (Lk 22:19)
- Paragraph 652: Christ's Resurrection is *the fulfilment of the promises* both of the Old Testament and of Jesus himself during his earthly life. The phrase 'in accordance with the Scriptures' indicates that Christ's Resurrection fulfilled these predictions.
- Paragraph 658: Christ, 'the first-born from the dead' (Col 1:18), is the principle of our own resurrection, even now by the justification of our souls, and one day by the new life he will impart to our bodies.



- ❖ The Lenten Penitential Service will be on Tuesday in Holy Week. I should like to try a different format this year. There will be Mass at 5pm as usual, followed by silent Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and individual confessions. I hope this change will be seen as more "user-friendly".
