From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 1536: Holy Orders is the sacrament through which the mission entrusted by Christ to his apostles continues to be exercised in the Church until the end of time: thus it is the sacrament of apostolic ministry. It includes three degrees: episcopate, presbyterate and diaconate.

Paragraph 1549: Through the ordained ministry, especially that of bishops and priests, the presence of Christ as head of the Church is made visible in the midst of the community of believers.

Paragraph 1551: This priesthood is *ministerial*. 'That office..., which the Lord committed to the pastors of his people, is in the strict sense of the term a *service*.'
