From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

- May is the month of Our Lady. Ask for her prayers.

Paragraph 1833: Virtue is a habitual and firm disposition to do good.

Paragraph 1840: The theological virtues dispose Christians to live in a relationship with the Holy Trinity. They have God for their origin, their motive and their object – God known by faith, God hoped in and loved for his own sake.

Paragraph 1841: There are three theological virtues: faith, hope and charity. They inform all the moral virtues and give life to them.

Paragraph 1842: By faith, we believe in God and believe all that he has revealed to us and that Holy Church proposes for our belief.

Paragraph 1843: By hope we desire, and with steadfast trust await from God, eternal life and the graces to merit it.

Paragraph 1844: By charity, we love God above all things and our neighbour as ourselves for love of God. Charity, the form of all the virtues, 'binds everything together in perfect harmony'.
