From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 1411: Only validly ordained priests can preside at the Eucharist and consecrate the bread and the wine so that they become the Body and Blood of the Lord.

Paragraph 1413: By the consecration the transubstantiation of the bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ is brought about.

Paragraph 1418: Because Christ himself is present in the sacrament of the altar, he is to be honoured with the worship of adoration. 'To visit the Blessed Sacrament is...a proof of gratitude, an expression of love, and a duty of adoration toward Christ our Lord'.
