From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 442: From the beginning this acknowledgement of Christ's divine sonship will be the centre of the apostolic faith, first professed by Peter as the Church's foundation.

Paragraph 551: From the beginning of his public life Jesus chose certain men, twelve in number, to be with him and to participate in his mission.

Paragraph 552: Simon Peter holds the first place in the college of the Twelve; Jesus entrusted a unique mission to him.

Paragraph 881: The Lord made Simon alone, whom he named Peter, the 'rock' of his Church. He gave him the keys of his Church, and instituted him shepherd of the whole flock.
