From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 851: It is from God's love for all men that the Church in every age receives both the obligation and the vigour of her missionary dynamism, 'for the love of Christ urges us on'.

Paragraph 854: By her very mission, 'the Church...travels the same journey as all humanity and shares the same earthly lot with the world: she is to be a leaven and, as it were, the soul of humanity in its renewal by Christ and transformation into the family of God. Missionary endeavour requires patience.

Paragraph 856: The missionary task requires a respectful dialogue with those who do not yet accept the Gospel. Believers can profit from this dialogue by learning to appreciate better 'those elements of truth and grace which are found among peoples, and which are, as it were, a secret presence of God'.
