From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 1342: From the beginning the Church has been faithful to the Lord's command.

Paragraph 1344: Thus from celebration to celebration, as they proclaim the Paschal mystery of Jesus 'until he comes', the pilgrim People of God advances, 'following the narrow way of the cross', toward the heavenly banquet, when all the elect will be seated at the table of the kingdom.

Paragraph 1387: To prepare for worthy reception of this sacrament, the faithful should observe the fast required in their Church.

Paragraph 1389: The Church obliges the faithful to take part in the Divine Liturgy on Sundays and feast days and, prepared by the sacrament of Reconciliation, to receive the Eucharist at least once a year, if possible during the Easter season.
