From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 713: The Messiah's characteristics are revealed above all in the 'Servant songs'. These songs proclaim the meaning of Jesus' Passion, and show how he will pour out the Holy Spirit to give life to the many: not as an outsider, but by embracing our 'form as slave'. Taking our death upon himself, he can communicate to us his own Spirit of life.

Paragraph 572: The Church remains faithful to the interpretation of 'all the Scriptures' that Jesus gave both before and after his Passover: 'Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into his glory?' Jesus' sufferings took their historical, concrete form from the fact that he was 'rejected by the elders and the chief priests and the scribes', who handed him 'to the Gentiles to be mocked and scourged and crucified'.

Paragraph 2046: By living with the mind of Christ, Christians hasten the coming of the Reign of God, 'a kingdom of justice, love and peace'.
