From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

- ❖ The Upper Room at Launceston is to be re-named The Richard McElroy Room after Fr. Richard McElroy CRL, parish priest here from 1920-1929 and founder of the Launceston Pilgrimage. It has been completely refurbished and will be used mainly for sacramental preparation for our young folk.
- ❖ The room will be open after morning Mass today and you are invited to view it. Please enter via the outer door, not by the spiral staircase.
- ❖ I have a piece of carpet left over from the refurbishment: reddish-brown, 89" length x 66" width. It's in the sacristy at Launceston. Please help yourself. What a bargain!
- ❖ Sacramental preparation: First Holy Communion – I have only two candidates so far. Are there any more? Confirmation – I have about seven candidates. Please meet me after the Youth Mass next Sunday to register and discuss details.
- ❖ Callington: Celebrate our church's dedication to Our Lady of Victories, which is the same as Our Lady of the Rosary. We will celebrate this festival with Mass at 5pm followed by Rosary and refreshments.
- ❖ Please pray for the priests of Cornwall Deanery who will be meeting next Tuesday. Nearly all of them have been newly appointed. I shall be giving them a brief talk about St. Cuthbert Mayne, whom they need to get to know.
- ❖ This Wednesday, work on the installation of CCTV at the Presbytery and church of St. Cuthbert Mayne will begin.
- ❖ Callington: Noah Breslin has been made a member of the Guild of St. Stephen for regular and faithful attendance as an Altar Server. I should like to find similar candidates at Bude and Launceston.
- ❖ Our Rosary group now comprises at least four different nationalities. Will you consider joining them after the 10am Mass every Saturday? We need to pray seriously for our lapsed Catholics, especially families, that they will be led by the Holy Spirit to a renewal of their Faith.

- ❖ Fr. Bernard Jones O.Carm: Many Bude parishioners, and probably some from Launceston and Holsworthy, will remember Fr. Bernard Jones, our retired Carmelite “Priest in Residence” from about 2004-2008. He always remembers his time in Bude with great affection. He is now seriously ill in Taunton Hospital. - ❖ The Books of Remembrance need to be updated during this month in time for November, the month of the Holy Souls. Please write any details in the back of the book.
