From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

- ❖ A tree near the lower car park is to be reduced in size during this week. It had begun to threaten our neighbour's house.
- ❖ This Tuesday there will be a Diocesan gathering of clergy at Haldon. I regret that there will be no Exposition and Mass. Please pray for us.
- ❖ Prayers too, please, for Fr. Cadoc Leighton O.Praem who on Wednesday will be inducted as Parish Priest of Camborne-Redruth by the new Dean of Cornwall, Fr. Peter Morgan.
- ❖ Please pray for me too as I struggle to get the new Diocesan Year Book ready for printing.
- ❖ Important dates in November: All Saints – 1st; All Souls – 2nd with Mass in Bude; Remembrance Sunday with visit to churchyard – 8th; Youth Mass – 15th.
- ❖ Post for Marriage Preparation support worker. See notice.
- ❖ Last week's Mass Count: Bude – 67; Launceston – 95; Callington – 34.
- ❖ Operation Christmas Child: an initiative of the Christian relief and development agency Samaritan's Purse. Gift-filled shoeboxes are wrapped and packed by children and adults in the UK and distributed to underprivileged children around the world. Please take a leaflet from the back of the church which explains the selection of items you can put in the boxes. The filled boxes need to be brought into church for collection on or before November 15th.
- ❖ Holy Year: Val Williams is organising a trip to Rome from 5th – 9th February 2016, staying at the Palazzola Villa, known as the English Venerable College, on a half-board basis. Trip includes an audience with Pope Francis in the Paul VI auditorium. Admission will be by

- ❖ Parish Building Fund: With the approval of the Finance Committee and the PPC I am giving you a blue envelope to encourage you to make a generous and realistic donation.

We are not yet in a crisis but we need funds to pay for: e.g. new lighting and sound system, renovation of some of the roof, re-painting of the main ceiling. The work will cost about £30,000. This is a conservative estimate.

Please Gift Aid if you can. This fund-raising effort will run for about a month. Please return envelopes to marked boxes. Gift Aid forms with instructions are also available.

- ❖ Launceston: CCTV cameras have now been installed in the church and presbytery.
- ❖ Our Safeguarding reps at Bude have resigned, having done the job for a number of years. Would anyone like to take this on? Please ask me.

- ❖ October is the month of the Holy Rosary. Our Rosary group now comprises at least four different nationalities. Will you consider joining them after the 10am Mass every Saturday? We need to pray seriously for our lapsed Catholics, especially families, that they will be led by the Holy Spirit to a renewal of their Faith.
