From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 962: We believe in the communion of all the faithful of Christ, those who are pilgrims on earth, the dead who are being purified, and the blessed in heaven, all together forming one Church.

Paragraph 2013: All Christians in any state or walk of life are called to the fullness of Christian life and to the perfection of charity. All are called to holiness: 'Be perfect, as your heavenly Father is perfect'.

Paragraph 2015: The way of perfection passes by way of the Cross. There is no holiness without renunciation and spiritual battle.

Paragraph 828: By canonising some of the faithful, i.e. by solemnly proclaiming that they practised heroic virtue and lived in fidelity to God's grace, the Church recognises the power of the Spirit of holiness within her and sustains the hope of believers by proposing the saints to them as models and intercessors.

- ❖ Next Sunday at Launceston we will observe the two minutes silence. After the Mass, weather permitting, we will process to the churchyard and say a “De Profundis” for our departed loved ones and for all our departed parishioners
- ❖ Post for Marriage Preparation support worker. See notice.
- ❖ Operation Christmas Child: an initiative of the Christian relief and development agency Samaritan’s Purse. Gift-filled shoeboxes are wrapped and packed by children and adults in the UK and distributed to underprivileged children around the world. Please take a leaflet from the back of the church which explains the selection of items you can put in the boxes. The filled boxes need to be brought into church for collection on or before November 15<sup>th</sup>. This is being organised by Debbie Lewis from Callington.
- ❖ Holy Year: Val Williams is organising a trip to Rome from 5<sup>th</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> February 2016, staying at the Palazzola Villa, known as the English Venerable College, on a half-board basis. - ❖ Parish Building Fund: With the approval of the Finance Committee and the PPC I am giving you a blue envelope to encourage you to make a generous and realistic donation. Cheques should be made payable to “PRCDTR St Cuthbert Mayne RC Parish”.
