From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 1042: At the end of time, the Kingdom of God will come in its fullness.

Paragraph 1052: 'We believe that the souls of all who die in Christ's grace...are the People of God beyond death. On the day of resurrection, death will be definitively conquered, when these souls will be reunited with their bodies'.

Paragraph 1055: By virtue of the 'communion of saints', the Church commends the dead to God's mercy and offers her prayers, especially the holy sacrifice of the Eucharist, on their behalf.
