From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 541: 'Now after John was arrested, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of God, and saying: "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: repent, and believe in the gospel."'

Paragraph 543: Everyone is called to enter the kingdom.

Paragraph 544: The kingdom belongs to the poor and the lowly, which means those who have accepted it with humble hearts.

Paragraph 545: Jesus invites sinners to the table of the kingdom: 'I came, not to call the righteous, but sinners.'

- ❖ The Feast of St. Cuthbert Mayne has been transferred to Saturday 28th November. Mass at the usual time will be followed by veneration of the major relic.
- ❖ Nikki and Peter Ware are collecting Christmas treats and non-perishable larder items (nice teas/coffee; chutneys and jams; pasta and rice) for the Poor Clare nuns at Lynton. There will be a box at Bude to receive these, and of course the people of Launceston and Callington are invited to contribute too. The last day for donations is Saturday 12th December.

- ❖ We have now received £3,382 from Tavistock parish in settlement of the money owed to the Callington community.
- ❖ The Confirmation Mass with Bishop Mark will be on Sunday 3rd April 2016 at Launceston: Divine Mercy Sunday. (Easter Sunday is on 25th March – very early).
- ❖ First Holy Communion group meeting after Mass today, 22nd November. The Mass of First Holy Communion will be on 15th May at Launceston: Pentecost Sunday.

- ❖ If there are any problems with these dates, please let me know.
- ❖ The Finance Committee meets after Mass at Launceston on Sunday 29th November. If you wish to raise any concerns please see a member of the Committee. Their names are on the notice boards.
- ❖ I have details of next year's Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes, from 28th May to 3rd June. See notices and start saving.
- ❖ Thank you to the parishioners from all our churches who have agreed to produce line drawings for mugs and tea towels.
- ❖ Parish Building Fund gifts: please return blue envelopes as soon as possible. So far, we have collected a total of £2,310 from our three communities. Thank you for your generosity.
- ❖ Free Parish Diaries for 2016 are now available. I ordered 200 so I hope there will be enough for everyone. Please help yourselves.
