From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 528: The Epiphany is the manifestation of Jesus as Messiah of Israel, Son of God and Saviour of the World. The great feast of Epiphany celebrates the adoration of Jesus by the wise men (*magi*) from the East, together with his baptism in the Jordan and the wedding feast at Cana in Galilee.

Paragraph 796: The unity of Christ and the Church, head and members of one Body, also implies the distinction of the two within a personal relationship. This aspect is often expressed by the image of bridegroom and bride.
