❖ Lent 2016:

At Sunday Mass:

- No flowers in church
- Alleluia and Gloria are omitted
- Eucharistic Acclamation 3: Save us, Saviour...
- Apostles' Creed rather than Nicene Creed
- Plainsong Sanctus and Agnus Dei

During the week:

- Stations of the Cross at all three churches
- Every Tuesday evening: Confessions at all three churches in rotation.

❖ Easter Sunday, 27<sup>th</sup> March: British Summer Time begins.

❖ The Easter Triduum: Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Vigil. Readers, Servers, Ministers of Holy Communion, Welcomers from Bude and Callington are invited to exercise their ministries at Launceston where these Liturgies will be held. We are one parish and I should like to emphasise this more clearly.

❖ Lourdes 2016: Bishop Mark has asked every parish to have a collection to help youth workers and sick pilgrims to take part in this pilgrimage. I should like to have a retiring collection on 14<sup>th</sup> February, the nearest Sunday to the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes.

❖ Building Fund Collection (blue envelopes): So far we have raised £3,690.00 and I'd like to give this fund-raising effort a rest for the time being. My heartfelt thanks to everyone who has contributed. Plans are slowly going ahead to continue with improvements at all three churches.

❖ Next Sunday I shall present our Candidates for First Holy Communion at the Launceston Mass. Please pray for them and their families.

❖ St. Peter's have been invited to host the local ecumenical Women's World Day of Prayer this year, at 10.30am on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> March. Please put this date in your diary and come if you can to join in prayer with our fellow Christians. Although it is still called the Women's World Day of Prayer, men are very welcome.

- ❖ Thank you to all parishioners who make their offerings using the gift aid scheme, so increasing every £1 they give to £1.25. If you are using the gift aid scheme, please remember that in each tax year you must have paid at least as much income tax and/or capital gains tax as the amount to be reclaimed from HMRC on all your gift aid donations to charities and Community Amateur Sports Clubs. If you think you may not be paying enough tax to cover your gift aid donations, please contact Alison in the Parish Office as soon as possible. Parishioners in the gift aid scheme should also notify Alison if there is any change of circumstances, such as change of name or address.
