- ❖ Easter Sunday, 27th March: British Summer Time begins.
 - ❖ Lourdes 2016: Bishop Mark has asked every parish to have a collection to help youth workers and sick pilgrims to take part in this pilgrimage. I should like to have a retiring collection today.
