From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 1443: During his public life Jesus not only forgave sins, but also made plain the effect of this forgiveness: he reintegrated forgiven sinners into the community of the People of God from which sin had alienated or even excluded them. A remarkable sign of this is the fact that Jesus receives sinners at his table, a gesture that expresses in an astonishing way both God's forgiveness and the return to the bosom of the People of God.

Paragraph 1486: The forgiveness of sins committed after Baptism is conferred by a particular sacrament called the sacrament of conversion, confession, Penance or Reconciliation.

Paragraph 1444: In imparting to his apostles his own power to forgive sins the Lord also gives them the authority to reconcile sinners with the Church.

- Palm Sunday, 20th March: Procession of Palms and Mass at all three churches at the usual times.
- The Easter Triduum: all at Launceston:
 - Maundy Thursday, 24th March: Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7pm followed by Watching and Prayer at the Altar of Repose until about 9.30pm.
 - Good Friday, 25th March: Liturgy of the Lord's Passion at 3pm. Stations of the Cross at Bude and Callington: times to be notified.
 - Easter Vigil, 26th March: Easter Vigil at 7.30pm.
 - Easter Sunday, 27th March: Mass at Callington at 7.45am and at Bude and Launceston at 10.00am.
