From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 621: Jesus freely offered himself for our salvation. Beforehand, during the Last Supper, he both symbolised this offering and made it really present: 'This is my body which is given for you'

Paragraph 623: By his loving obedience to the Father, 'unto death, even death on a cross', Jesus fulfils the atoning mission of the suffering Servant, who will 'make many righteous; and he shall bear their iniquities'.



- ❖ Confirmation Sunday, 3<sup>rd</sup> April: This Mass is likely to be very crowded. If any of you would like a quiet Mass I should be prepared to celebrate one at 12 noon. Please put your name on the list at the back of the church as soon as possible.
- ❖ Confirmation group: A reminder that the rehearsal will be on Thursday 31<sup>st</sup> March at 5pm in the Charles Langdon Room. Attendance is important, so let me know if you are unable to get to it.
- ❖ There will be a Mass at Bude on 23<sup>rd</sup> March, thanks to Fr. Kevin. I shall be at the Chrism Mass.
- ❖ Progress report on various improvements, large and small:
  - Launceston: the doors on the new building have been adjusted. The wooden floors in the two chapels have been beautifully re-stained.
  - Callington: a lovely brass crucifix has been cleaned and polished. A metal bowl and jug for washing of feet on Maundy Thursday have been given to us. It certainly beats my washing-up bowl. The pipe organ is gradually being assembled and with luck will be playable by Easter Sunday.
- ❖ I should like to recruit about 4-6 people to have their feet washed at the Mass of the Lord's Supper, ideally at least one person from each of our communities. Women are now officially allowed to volunteer.
- ❖ Bude: there will be a retiring collection today for Easter flowers.
- ❖ Gift Aid: HMRC has made changes to the tax regulations for the next year. Please see poster for details.
- ❖ Summer Camps 2016: Applications are now being taken for places at the Plymouth Diocese Catechetical Summer Camps, to be held at
