From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 645: By means of touch and the sharing of a meal, the risen Jesus establishes direct contact with his disciples. He invites them in this way to recognise that he is not a ghost and above all to verify that the risen body in which he appears to them is the same body that had been tortured and crucified.

Paragraph 1137: The book of Revelation of St. John, read in the Church's liturgy, first reveals to us, 'A throne stood in heaven, with one seated on the throne': 'the Lord God'. It then shows the Lamb, 'standing as though it had been slain': Christ crucified and risen, the one high priest of the true sanctuary, the same one 'who offers and is offered, who gives and is given'.

Paragraph 1139: It is in this eternal liturgy that the Spirit and the Church enable us to participate whenever we celebrate the mystery of salvation in the sacraments.
