From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 243: Before his Passover, Jesus announced the sending of 'another Paraclete' (Advocate), the Holy Spirit. At work since creation, having previously 'spoken through the prophets, the Spirit will now be with and in the disciples, to teach them and guide them 'into all the truth'. The Holy Spirit is thus revealed as another divine person with Jesus and the Father.

Paragraph 692: When he proclaims and promises the coming of the Holy Spirit, Jesus calls him the 'Paraclete', literally, 'he who is called to one's side', *advocatus*. 'Paraclete' is commonly translated by 'consoler' and Jesus is the first consoler. The Lord also called the Holy Spirit 'the Spirit of truth'.
