From the Catechism of the Catholic Church (slightly adapted):

Paragraph 692: When he proclaims and promises the coming of the Holy Spirit, Jesus calls him the 'Paraclete', literally, 'he who is called to one's side', *advocatus*. 'Paraclete' is commonly translated by 'consoler', and Jesus is the first consoler. The Lord also called the Holy Spirit 'the Spirit of truth'.

Paragraph 731: On the day of Pentecost when the seven weeks of Easter had come to an end, Christ's Passover is fulfilled in the outpouring of the Holy Spirit, manifested, given and communicated as a divine person: of his fullness, Christ, the Lord, pours out the Spirit in abundance.

Paragraph 776: The Church 'is the visible plan of God's love for humanity', because God desires 'that the whole human race may become one People of God, form one Body of Christ, and be built up into one temple of the Holy Spirit'.
